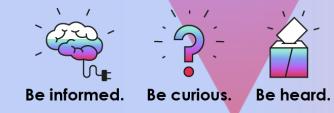




As the autumn term draws to a close, teachers and pupils are looking forward to the winter break.


In recent weeks, people have been discussing the length of school holidays.

This could see children in Wales having a five-week holiday in the summer. Schools would then get a two-week break in October instead.


Individual activity (5-10 mins)

I feel exhausted in the autumn term. I'd like an extra week of holiday to rest and relax.


