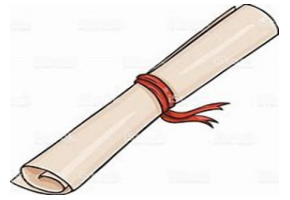
Welcome to Mr Barlow - Our new minibus driver
