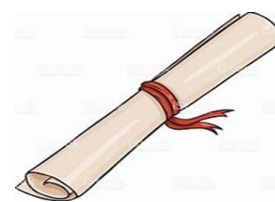

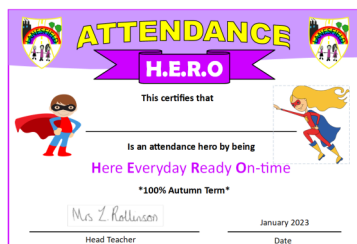

- Between 10am and 11am there will be a drop-in session for parents to come in to discuss any concerns.

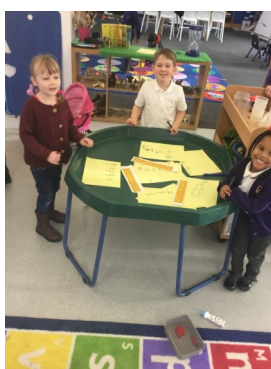
Parents' Evenings

Parents' evenings will take place on 14th and 15th February. Meetings will all be of 10 minutes duration

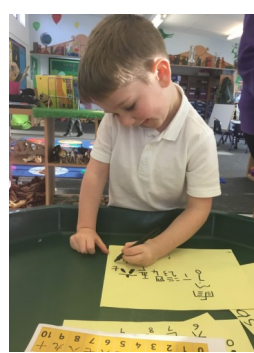
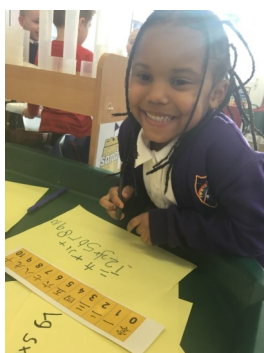
14th February meetings will be held in school from 3.40pm until 6pm.

15th February meetings will be held virtually, via Showbie from 4.30pm until 7pm.

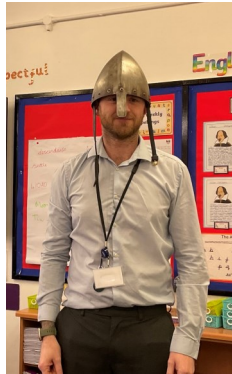
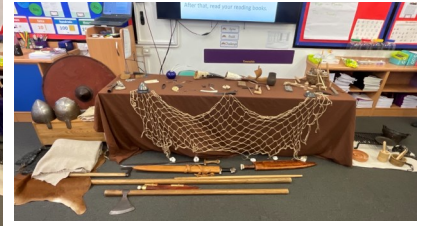

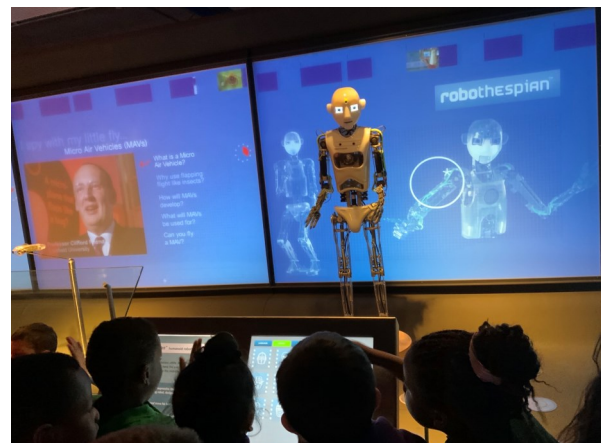

Anglo-Saxon day in Green Class

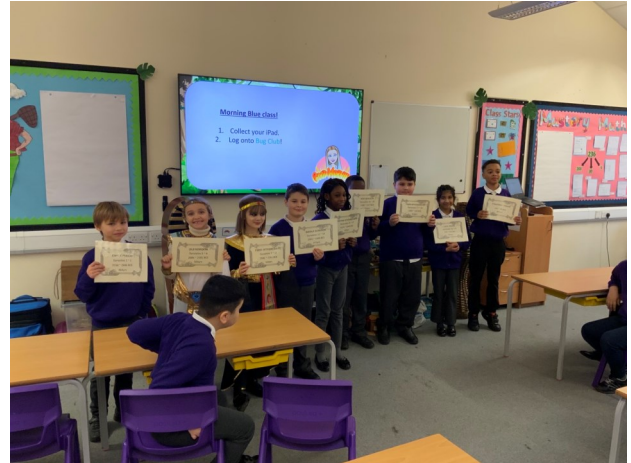
