Children have been grouped based on their choices.










Creativity takes courage...but it's a huge amount of fun!

Important note

What to bring!

Children will need a packed lunch for when we first arrive on Wednesday. We will send paper bags home for these to reduce baggage.

In addition to your everyday clothes:

- Toiletries: toothbrush and paste, shower gel, towel, deodorant (not aerosol spray)
- Nightwear
- Coat
- Sensible flat shoes with grip, or trainers for indoors
- Trainers or shoes for outdoor use
- Sun hat and sun cream
- Water bottle
- Slippers (optional only to be worn on the dormitory corridors)
- Plastic bag for dirty clothing.

Subject specific:

- Art overalls or an old shirt to cover clothing
- Dance black t-shirt and black joggers or leggings
- **Drama** loose, comfy clothes
- Music you are welcome to bring an instrument.

Please label all items and pack items in a suitcase or bag that the children can carry up stairs.

Commonly asked questions...

- Can my child bring their own food? There is a huge range of food available for your children to snack on and eat. With the exception of the first day, your child doesn't need to bring their own food. If they are a 'picky' eater, alternative food can be provided.
- Does my child need pocket money? No, there is nowhere on site for them to buy anything and we wouldn't want them to lose their money.
- Can my child have a phone with them so I can contact them? Phones are not permitted for safeguarding reasons. You will receive online communication through Showbie.
- Where will be the photo updates be? We will ensure all your children have added the classroom code on Showbie (ZABMG). Log into your child's Showbie account and you will see daily updates and photos on there. There might be some on our school socials but Showbie is the main place for daily updates.
- Where can I access this information? This will be within the Ingestre Hall folder including a voice recording of any additional questions asked tonight.
