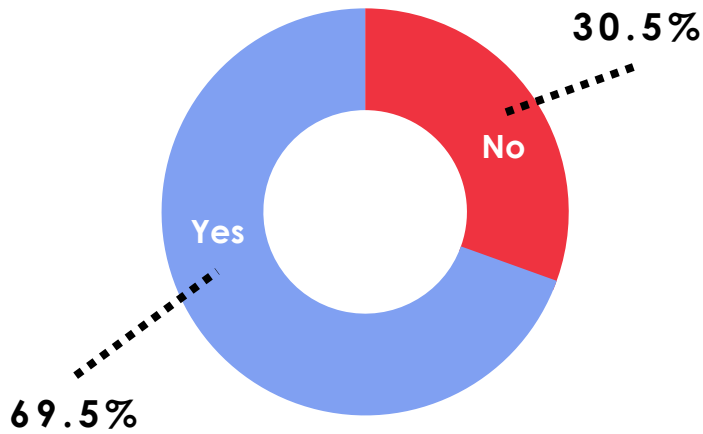
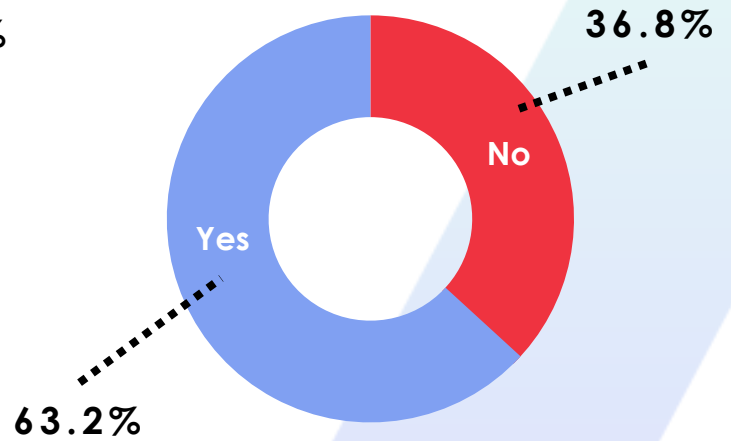

A CLOSER LOOK: ZERO WASTE WEEK



Zero Waste Week 2023 is happening between 4th-8th September.

Zero Waste Week started in 2008. It is a time for us all to think about what we consider to be “rubbish” and how we can reduce, reuse or recycle things rather than throwing them away.

In 2021, people in the UK threw away nearly 10 million tonnes of waste, which then went to landfill. But, there was lots of recycling too! The materials that were recycled the most were metal (like cans), glass (like bottles), and paper and cardboard (like boxes). Hopefully even more recycling will happen in 2023.

Hurricane Idalia has become a Category 4 hurricane. This means that wind speeds could reach 130 miles per hour! People have been told to leave Florida as soon as possible.



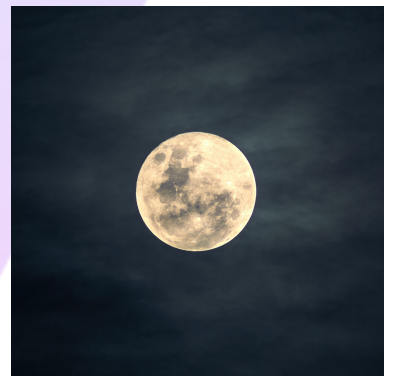
Bonuses cancelled after strikes
