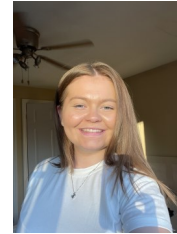

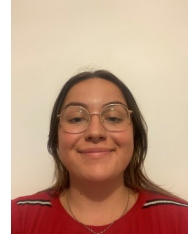

Children's flu vaccinations will be carried out in school on 29th November.

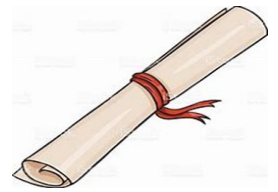

Donated Uniform - Help

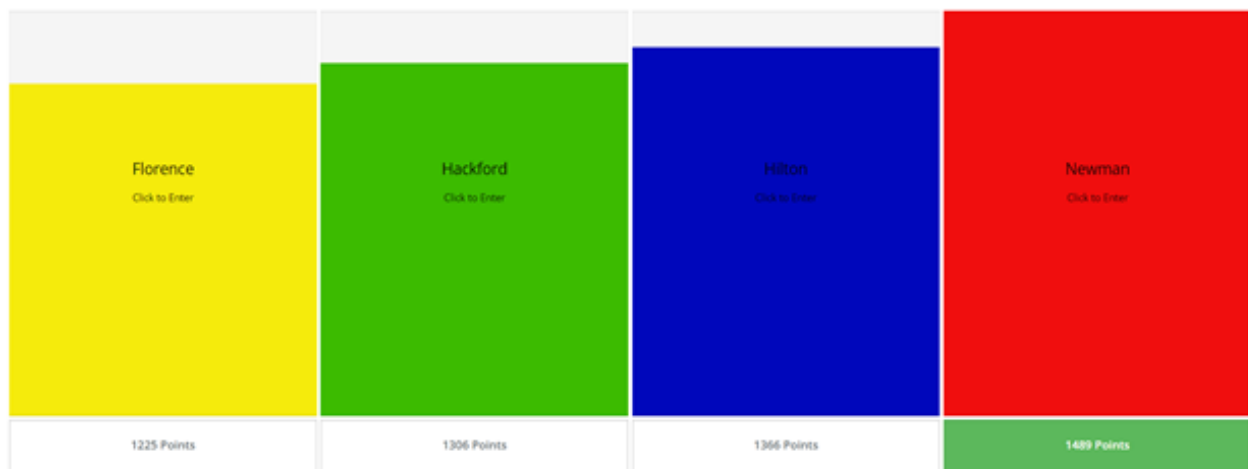
We are very lucky to have lots of donated uniform in school.
