

## PRIMARY 5-7 LESSON PLAN

# SHOULD WE ALWAYS GIVE BACK OBJECTS WHEN PEOPLE ASK FOR THEM?

### Learning objectives:

1. To learn about the role of museums in displaying and sharing objects.
2. To consider their own feelings and behaviour around returning objects.

### Keywords:

1. Museum
2. Object
3. Collection

### Feedback | Whole class

Voters see the results and feedback from last week's topic.

### Section 1: 2-3 mins | Pair

Voters will see three keywords and they will need to match the keywords to their definitions. They will be shown the correct answers before they move on.

### Section 2: 3-5 mins | Pair and whole class

Voters will reflect on their own experience of museums. Then, they will learn about how objects come into museums and learn that some people want some objects to be returned to where they were made.

### Section 3: 2-3 mins | Pair

Voters will reflect on special objects that they have in their own lives, and share this with a partner.

### Section 4: 4-6 mins | Whole class

Voters will learn about some special objects which people have asked to be returned from museums. They will decide whether the museum returned the item or kept it using hand gestures.

### Section 5: 8-10 mins | Pair

Voters will see a range of situations where someone has a problem with returning an item. They will share their opinion about what should happen with their partner, using sentence starters to support them.

### Voting | Whole class
