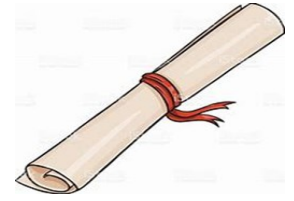

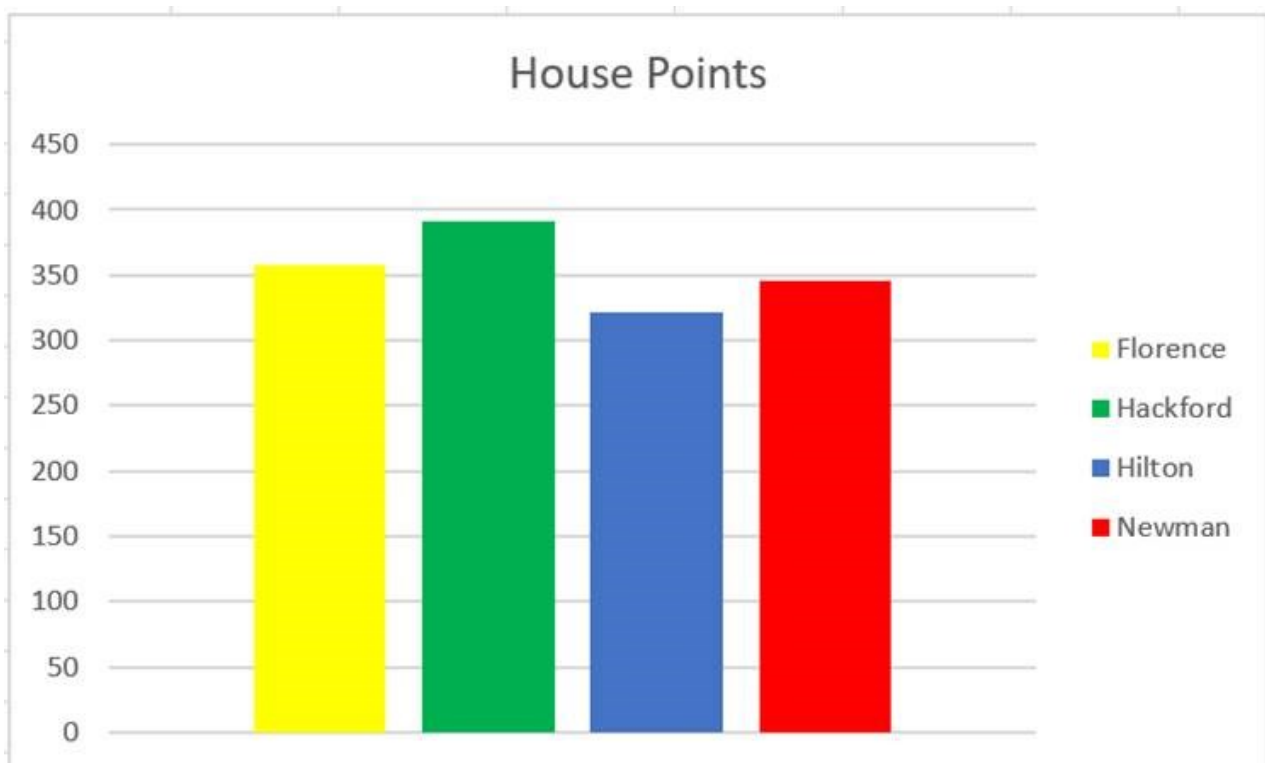

We expect children to look after these; however, if your child damages an Ipad or Ipad accessories we will ask parents for a contribution towards the costs of repair or replacement. Thank you.

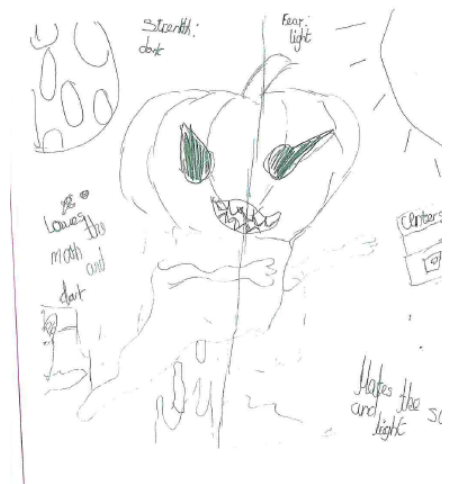
## Well done to our League of Lanesfield children Inaayah, Iman, Evelyn and Emily
