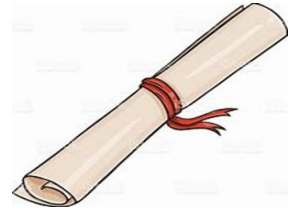

Leave of Absence Requests/Holiday in Term time
