Comic relief have advised that this years red noses are not suitable for under 7's, because of this we have not purchased any.

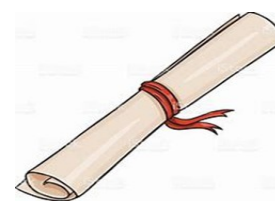
We have a small selection of red noses from last year that can be purchased for £1.50.
